

High Level Panel on Human Rights Mainstreaming February 24th, 2025

RE: Oral Statement delivered during the 58th Session of the Human Rights Council

Mr President,

Women Deliver makes this statement on behalf of 114 CSOs.

We join the Council in celebrating 30 years since the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action was unanimously adopted, firmly declaring that women's rights, as human rights, include the right to have control over and decide freely on their sexuality, including sexual and reproductive health.

In this time, human rights standards on gender equality have advanced significantly, thanks to this Council, the mobilization of feminist movements, human rights defenders and civil society, and the tireless work of Treaty Bodies, Special Procedures, and UN Agencies. As a fundamental principle of international human rights law, there should be no retrogression. In this spirit, we commend the full recognition, by consensus, of sexual and reproductive health and rights adopted by this Council last year.

Despite normative progress, the promises made to women and girls in all their diversity at Beijing remain a distant dream for many, including women and girls facing multiple and intersecting forms of discrimination, such as those with disabilities, adolescent girls, indigenous women and girls, and trans women. Current estimates suggest that by 2030, the world will be less gender-equal than 2015.

We urge all Member States to respect, protect and fulfil the human rights of all women and girls, honouring the commitments made both at *and since* Beijing. We also call on this Council to prioritize and protect space for civil society and Human Rights Defenders. Feminists have fought for the progress achieved over the last 30 years and we will continue to fight until gender equality is a reality for everyone
